- 4. Ensure consistent engagement with relevant PJHQ Divisions, external agencies, Operation HQs, NGOs, OGDs, other HQs and FLCs.
- 5. Manage training deficiencies and waiver applications submitted by the single Services to determine aggregated risk held by the Joint Commander.
- 6. Act as lead for the FP team in change programmes and organisational development opportunities.
- 7. Promote an inclusive culture within PJHQ, working to increase understanding and engagement through education and initiative.
- 8. Provide coverage for other FP desk officers (Euro Atlantic and Africa) when they are deployed or away.
- 9. All other tasks as directed by the CoC.
